Join us in identifying the most common academic performance problems that arise, why they occur and what we can do to promote success at home and in the classroom.

Behavior Management

October 23, 2024

Why are behavioral strategies helpful? What are some effective behavioral strategies for ADHD? What are the limitations of behavioral strategies for ADHD? Join us as we explore these and other questions, as well as behavioral treatments and how they may help the child with ADHD be successful.

Medications

Parents often have questions about medications for ADHD and may be apprehensive about using medications for treating ADHD in their child. This session offers an in-depth discussion on the physiology of ADHD, the variety of medication options available for treating ADHD and how they function.

Self-Esteem

Are you wondering how to help your child with ADHD have better self-esteem? In this class, we will expand and improve your understanding of how self-esteem develops, how ADHD may impact self-esteem, as well as learn ways to improve and support the self-esteem of the child with ADHD.

Social Skills

April 15, 2025

Children with ADHD often have difficulties with personal interactions. In this course, we will discuss ADHD behaviors and how they may impact social skill development. We will also help parents identify areas for improvement in their own child and examine practical strategies to help parents encourage and reinforce positive social skill development.

ADHD ACADEMY Topic-Focused Course Offerings (Cont.)

Stress Management

October 17, 2024

Research has shown that parents of children with ADHD suffer high levels of stress, depression, anxiety, blame, and marital discord. These high levels, left untreated, can lead to health issues and negatively affect the quality of life for everyone. This session focuses on how parents can take good care of themselves.

Classes for kids (parents come with them)

Just for Siblings

Do you ever get upset with your brother or sister? Do you wonder why he/she seems to get "all the attention?" This session is designed to help school-age siblings better understand what the deal is with ADHD, why their siblings act the way they do, and what they can do to help the situation for themselves and their family. *This class is for children ages 8-12, who have a sibling with ADHD only. <u>The child with</u> <u>ADHD should not attend this class.</u> All children must be accompanied by an adult.*

What is This Thing Called ADHD?

October 26, 2024, from 9-10 a.m. — Westerville *Close to Homessa* May 10, 2025, from 9-10 a.m. — Westerville *Close to Homessa* Join us as we help your child recognize their potential by learning what ADHD means and what it looks like for them. Our behavioral health staff will help your child understand what ADHD is and how/when it might affect them the most, identify who their "team" is and how they can work together with their team to facilitate a more positive result. *This class is for children ages 8-12, with ADHD only. All children must be accompanied by an adult.*
