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Program Description

Learning sign language can be a fun experience and help you communicate with people in the Deaf and hard of hearing community.

ASL I – This class is an introduction to American Sign Language and its culture. Students will learn the alphabet, numbers, basic vocabulary and beginning sentence structure.

ASL II – This class continues to teach sentence structure, descriptions and more advanced vocabulary.

Topics

- Grammar and structure of ASL
- Fingerspelling the alphabet
- Signing numbers
- Simple phrases and interactions
- Vocabulary

Teacher

Julie Brosious is an ASL and Deaf Studies certified instructor. Julie was born deaf in one ear. She is employed at Nationwide Children's Hospital and enjoys teaching ASL for both staff and the community.

Who Should Attend?

This program is for anyone who is 11 years and older. Youth and adults are encouraged to attend.

This class requires a minimum of six (6) registrants. Participants will be notified ONE WEEK in advance if the class has been canceled.

Location

These classes will be either virtual or in-person. Location for in-person classes will be at Nationwide Children's Hospital or East *Close To Home*SM Center.
