Program Description

Introduction of basic diabetes management for adults who care for children with diabetes.

Intended Audience:

This is a three-hour program designed for healthcare professionals. Upon completion, learners will be able to provide safe and appropriate diabetes care in the school, daycare, and home settings. Topics include differentiation of type 1 and type 2 diabetes; how to count carbohydrates and calculate insulin doses; use of glucose meters, continuous glucose monitors, and insulin pumps; and acute care for hypo and hyperglycemia, including ketones.

This class is for adult learners only. Please do not bring children to this class.
