Adult-Infant-Child CPR Classes

Program Description:

Be prepared in case of an emergency with Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). During the COVID-19 pandemic, after registration you will be sent a link to online material you MUST complete before the actual class date. On that date, you will be scheduled for a time to do your skills test. Couples registered for the class can come together to do their skills test. Everyone else comes individually. Each participant will receive a Nationwide Children's Hospital CPR card after course completion. Class size is limited to six people. This course meets O.D.E. requirements for coaches. Must be an adult or a child age 11 or older to attend.

- Risk Factors
- AHA Chain of Survival
- Signals and Actions for Survival
