- 12. The participant will be able to list the benefits of a multidisciplinary approach to complex aerodigestive disorders.
- 13. The participant will be able to discuss the patients who will most benefit from evaluation and management in the Pediatric Aerodigestive Disorders Clinic.
- 14. The participant will be able to review and state the role of clinic nursing staff and strategies to enhance competencies for patient care.
- 15. The participant will be able to discuss strategies for managing clinic flow in a high-volume surgical clinic.
