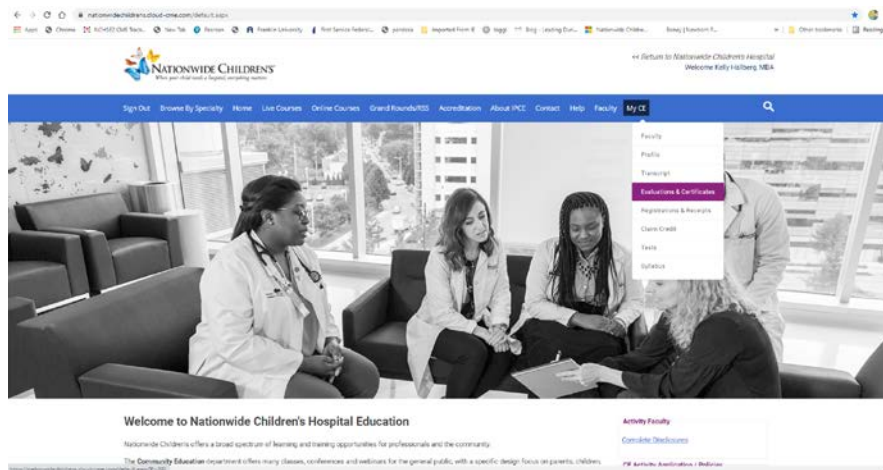


Instructions for completing an EVALUATION

Follow these log-in instructions to complete your evaluation.

1. Go to <https://nationwidechildrens.cloud-cme.com>
2. Click "Sign In" on the upper left-hand side. *Nationwide Children's employees MUST use "Sign in with your Nationwide Children's Hospital ID" to sign on using your NCH single sign on (NCH email and password).
3. Once signed in, click the "My CE" button in the top right.
4. Click "Evaluations and Certificates" to complete the activity evaluation.
5. Click "Transcript" to access your transcript records.
